A significant part of the future of the chapel is the current [restoration project](#) that will remove the current render on the outside of the building, conduct any repairs to the framework of the building and then re-render using traditional materials.

Plans for the repair and conservation of the building will be on display at the event. These proposals have been developed with the help of Kirstie Robbins of the Ptolemy Dean Architects Ltd, The Churches Conservation Trust, the Historic Chapels Trust and both East Suffolk Council and Historic England.

Once your comments have been received and incorporated into the plans, we should be in a position to apply formally for Listed Buildings Consent and to seek further funding for the works.

The event will provide an opportunity for you to see and discuss the plans with members of the project team, as well as meeting chapel supporters.
