
WALPOLE OLD CHAPEL DEED 1689 Transcribed by Philip Gorrod and Catherine Draper 2023

Introduction

In 1689 King William III and Parliament passed the Act of Toleration which gave nonconformists freedom of worship. In that same year the six trustees of the Walpole congregation received a lease on the building that became the Chapel, with an acre of land, from the Corporation of Southwold. The annual rent was ten shillings. These trustees were local men of some substance: Richard Whincop, gentleman, and Joshua Nunn, yeoman, of Spexhall; Thomas Reeve, yeoman, and Samuel Folkard, grocer, of Walpole; John Fella, cordwainer, and John Hugman, glover, of Halesworth. It is not known how the town of Southwold came to own land in Walpole, but the site was probably part of the surrounding farm leased at that time to Joseph Skoulding, named as occupier of this building. It is possible that the land may once have belonged to the dissolved Sibton Abbey which had sizeable holdings in Walpole.

Editorial Note

The deed is written as a continuous piece of legal prose and as such is not easy to follow for the lay reader. Changes of topic or clause are only indicated by bold writing of words. (see photograph). For ease of understanding paragraphs have been inserted at these bold headings. In addition, annotated headings in red have been used to show how similar the structure of this document is to a modern day lease.



Notes on the Transcription

Letters in () have been inserted to improve readability, but do not appear in the original document.

Letters in italics denote use of a symbol in the original text which replaces a group of letters such as the *ver* in every and which is not in common usage today. There seems to be no difference between a capital C and a c used at the beginning of the word.

The Property and Rights Leased

All that piece of Land or pasture w(i)th a house thereupon latelybuilt lying & being in Walpoole afores(ai)^d Invironed & Compassed about w(i)th the Kings highway there in p(ar)t & the Lands of George Fleetwood Esq^r in p(ar)t on e*very* p(ar)t & Contain(e)d by Estimat(i)on one acre more or less & is now in the Tenure or Occupat(i)on of one Joseph Skoulding his Assignee or Assignees. Together w(i)th all the Wayes Waters Easem(en)^{ts} privilidges & app*ur*ten(a)nc(e)s to the said piece of Land or pasture & all & sing(u)l(a)r other the p*re*misses or any p(ar)t of p(ar)cell thereof belonging or in any wise app(er)taining

Rights Reserved to Lessors

Except & alwayes Reserved out of this p*re*sent Demise & grant unto the said Bayliffs & Comonalty & their Successors & to the said George Warren Thomas Postle John Postle James Archer John Aldred & Richard Wainfleet their heirs & Assigns all & all manner of Tymber Wood Underwood & Trees now growing or being or w(hi)^{ch} hereafter shall or may grow or be upon the said Demised p*re*misses or any p(ar)t or p(ar)cell thereof And also free Lib*er*ty of Ingress Egress & Regress for themselves & e*ver*y of them their & e*ver*y of their s*erv*ants carts & horses to & from the said Demised p*re*misses or any p(ar)t thereof from time to time & at all times to view & see the State & Condit(i)on thereof And also to fell stubb cut downe lop & top all such Tymber Wood Underwood & Trees growing or being upon the said Demised p*re*misses or any p(ar)t thereof as they or any of them shall please & there to let it

lye or else w(i)th servants carts & horses to load it & carry it of(f) the said Demised premisses when they or any of them shall thinke most meet & convenient

Lease Period and Start Date

To Have and to Hold the said piece of Land or pasture & all & sing(u)I(a)r other the premisses before ment(i)o(n)ed to be Demised w(i)th their & every of their app*ur*ten*a*nc(e)s (Except before Excepted) unto the said Richard Whincopp Thomas Reeve Samuell Folkard Joshua Nunn John Fella & John Longman their Executors Administrators & Assigns from the Feast day of St Michaell Th'archangell w(hi)^{ch} shall be in the yeare of o*ur* Lord God one thousand six hundred ninety & one for & during & unto the full end & Terme of Ninety & nine years from thencenext ensuing & fully to be Compleat and Ended w(i)thout Impeachm(en)^t of or for any manner of Wast in the houses & Edifices already built or that hereafter shall be built upon the said Demised p*re*misses or any p(ar)t thereof & with Lib*er*ty to Comitte Wast in the houses or any p(ar)t thereof

Amount of Lease and Payment Dates

Yeilding & paying therefore yearly & ev(e)ry yeare during the Continuance of this present Demise unto the said Bayliffs & Comonalty & their Successors the yearly Rent or sume of Tenn shillings of Lawfull English money at the two most usuall Feasts or Terms of paym(en)^t in the yeare That is to say the Feast day of Th'annunciat(i)on of the blessed Lady Mary the Virgin & St Michaell Th'archangell by even & equall portions At the markett cross in Southwould afores(ai)^d

Penalties for Rent Arrears

And if it shall happen the said yearly Rent of Tenn shillings above reserved or any p(ar)t or p(ar)cell thereof to be behind or unpaid during the space of Tenn dayes next after any of the said Feasts or dayes of $paym(en)^t$ at $w(hi)^{ch}$ the same ought to be paid as afores(ai)^d That then & so often it shall & may be Lawfull to & for the said Bayliffs & Comonalty & their Successors into the said Demised p*re*misses & e*very* p(ar)t thereof to enter & there to Distraine & the Distress & Distresses there found &

taken to chase lead drive take Impound Detaine & keep untill the said Rent together w(i)th the arrea(ra)ges thereof (if any there shall be) & also all such Charges & Expences whatsoev(e)r as shall be laid out & Expended in & about the reco*very* of the same shall be well & truly satisfied & paid

The Lessees Covenant to meet the payment terms

The Lessees may take timber for hedges and fences

And the said Bayliffs & Comonalty for themselves & their Successors do covenant & grant to & w(i)th the said Richard Whincopp Thomas Reeve Samuell Folkard Joshua Nunn John Fella & John Longman their Executors Administrators & Assigns & to and w(i)th every of them by these presents in manner & forme following That is to say that it shall & may be Lawfull to & for the said Richard Whincopp Thomas Reeve Samuell Folkard Joshua Nunn John Fella & John Longman their Executors Administrators & Assigns & every of them yearly & every yeare during this Demise to cut & take upon the said Demised premisses or some p(ar)t thereof so many bushes & other fenceing stuffe whatsoever as shall be needfull & necessary for the repairing & amending the hedges & fences belonging to the said Demised p*re*misses if so much can there be found

'Quiet Enjoyment' for the Lessees

And Finally that they the said Richard Whincopp Thomas Reeve Samuell Folkard Joshua Nunn John Fella & John Longman their Executors Administrators & Assigns & every of them (paying the said yearly Rent of Tenn shillings beforereserved & p(er)forming the Covenants & Articles afores(ai)^d on their & every of their p(ar)ts to be kept & p(er)formed according to the true Intent & meaning of these presents) shall or Lawfully may quietly and peaceably have hold occupy possess & enjoy all & sing(u)l(a)r the said Demised premisses & every p(ar)t & p(ar)cell thereof according to the true Intent & meaning of these presents w(i)thout the let Sute trouble Deniall Interrupt(i)on Eviction or Expulsion of the said Bayliffs & Comonalty & their Successors or any other p(er)son or p(er)sons Claiming or to Claime by from or under them or any of them
